### **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

Students experience success if there is continuity of attendance. It is important that students attend Greek school frequently, as this will enhance their learning.

If a student misses a significant number of lessons it could prevent the student from advancing to the next level.

### **GRADUATION POLICY**

Students will only graduate if they have demonstrated sufficient attendance, completion of schoolwork and homework.

### **CURRICULUM MATTERS**

\* Year 6, 7 and the year 4 students using the bluebook, will be issued with a reading book and workbook. The cost of both books has increased to \$55.00. If you already have a reading book (ie year 5 and 6 students will be given book 6 and year 4 students will be given book 2) the cost will be \$31.00.

The book fee needs to be paid by 27<sup>th</sup> May 2011. Payment after this date will incur an extra administration fee of \$10.00 per child. Payment can be made to Afroditis Devrelis.

\* Teaching staff request that parents/caregivers refrain from disrupting the classes by conducting discussions outside the classroom. If a parent wishes to talk to a teacher please do so after the lesson or by appointment. Additionally, we request parents to wait outside the classrooms, ie under the verandah, to collect their child(ren).

### **HOMEWORK POLICY**

The teachers give homework on regular bases to their students. If your child needs to leave early then they must discuss with their teacher what homework needs to be done prior to next lesson. If a student has been absent it is important to contact others as appropriate and obtain the homework. It is important that all of the homework is completed by the due date. This will help to build up the student's confidence and knowledge in the language. If any students fail to complete a significant amount of their homework, and as a result have not made sufficient progress, it would prevent them from advancing to the next level.



## **NUT FREE**

We request that no nuts or products containing nuts are allowed at the school. This includes peanut butter, nutella, muesli bars and anything cooked using nut oils. We have children who are allergic to nuts.



## **HEALTH CARE PLANS**

The school needs a doctor approved health care plan from children who are on ongoing medication or are asthmatic. Forms may be obtained from Afroditis Devrelis.

## **COMMUNICATION DIARY**

All students have been issued a Communication Diary. In this diary students write their homework and communication between the school, teacher and home can occur. If you need to discuss something with the class teacher please feel free to write in the diary.

## **SUNDAY SCHOOL**

Just a friendly reminder St Nectarios holds Sunday School immediately after Holy Communion every Sunday. The lesson continues until the end of the service whereby the children are returned back to the church in time to receive *antidoron* (church bread).

Although many children receive religious education in their daily schooling or attend our Orthodox Colleges, attending Sunday School will allow children to become a part of the parish life



through learning about the Gospel message and actively participate in the celebrations of the feast days of the church.

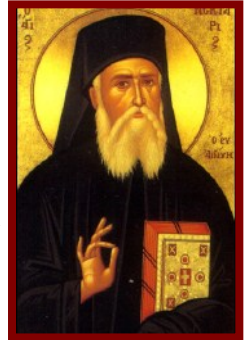
## **SCHOOL FEES**
